RoHS Compliance Statement

Impulse is committed to the protection of our environment and is taking the steps necessary to meet the challenges of new regulatory requirements as they arise.

A recent challenge is the Restriction of Hazardous Substances (RoHS) Directive of the European Union. RoHS restricts the use of lead, cadmium, mercury, hexavalent chromium, Polybrominated Biphenyl (PBB) and Polyrominated Diphenyl Ether (PBDE) flame retardants in electrical and electronic equipment from July 1st 2006 onwards.

Impulse is committed to fully comply with the RoHS Directive and conversion of existing product families to RoHS compliance have been met where possible. Our website and product packaging clearly shows the products which are RoHS compliant.

WEEE Compliance Statement

The European Union also adopted Directive 2002/96/EC on Waste Electrical and Electronic Equipment (WEEE), with requirements that went into effect on August 13th 2005. WEEE is intended to reduce the disposal of waste from electrical and electronic equipment by establishing guidelines for prevention, reuse, recycling and recovery.
